

Frequently asked questions

### **What is a ladder league?**

A ladder league has rungs of either 4 or 5 players. Each rung is determined by points scored. The highest 4 or 5 scores will be rung 1, the next 4 or 5 will be rung 2. You play 6 or 8 games, depending on the number of players, with each member of the rung. Your score from each game is recorded to determine standings on the ladder.

### **Are there prizes for the winners of the league?**

Medals will be given out for each division. You must play in at least 4 weeks to qualify for medals.

### **What if I can't make it one week?**

If you can't make it for any reason it is your responsibility to find a sub.

### **Is there a list of substitute players?**

There will be a list of players not in the league that will be available to fill in if someone cannot make it. Points will be given to the sub not the person that can't make it.

### **How is score keeping done?**

Each rung of the ladder will have a captain that will keep track of scores and hand them into the league secretary. Scoring will be determined by the number of entries.

The ladder may be configured for any number of points per game. The following example assumes the default of 8 points. Playing percentage is based on the number of points scored divided by the number of points possible (64 for a 8 game match of 8 points per game).

Example: If 62 points were scored out of a possible 64 it would calculate as 62 divided by 64 for a score of 97%

### **When will I play?**

3.5 and 4.0 play on Tuesdays at either 7, 8:30, depending on how many people sign up and where you are on the ladder.

2.5 and 3.0 play on Thursdays at either 7, 8:30, depending on how many people sign up and where you are on the ladder.
