

## Boss of the Brine League Instructions:

There are two divisions: Intermediate and Advanced. Each division will use 4 courts.

There are two sessions: 6:00 and 7:30.

Players sign up as individuals and are randomly paired with a partner for the first game, the first week. The standings will be based on wins. The remaining weeks of leagues will be positioned on courts by standings.

All games will start at the same time. Either a whistle will be blown or some sort of signal to start. Please be on the courts when the league starts.

Games will be timed. All games will be played for 8-10 minutes. Points will still be scored like they normally would be. Keep playing even if you reach 11 points. Basically, score as many points as you can in the time frame. At the end of the time frame a whistle will be blown signaling the end of the game. If you are in a rally continue until that point is ended. If the score is tied another rally will be played and whoever wins that rally will get the win. You do not need to be the serving team to win the final point.

At the end of each game the winners of that game will move up a court and the non-winners will move down. If you are on court one and win you will stay on court one. If you are on court 4 and are a non-winner, you stay on court 4. When you move from one court to another you will split and play with a player from your new court. When you move to the new court there will be a process in place that will determine which partner you will play with. (random partner)

Since the games are timed, it is important to keep things moving between games. We will work in some small breaks along the way, but we need to limit time between games. We plan to play as many games as possible in 1.5 hours of play. At the end of the league, whoever finishes with the most wins in each skill level will be the BOSS OF THE BRINE LEAGUE CHAMPION.
