

King/Queen of the Court Doubles League Instructions:

There are three divisions:

Women's Intermediate (Combined DUPR must be 7.2 or below, WOMEN ONLY)

The following two groups can be any combination of mixed, man/man, or woman/woman
DUPR 7.24 and below combined DUPR
DUPR 7.25 to 8.3 combined DUPR

Each division will use 4 courts. Each division must play at the same time.

There are three sessions:

8:00 Women's Intermediate

9:30 DUPR 7.25 to 8.3

11:00 DUPR 7.24 and below

Players sign up as a doubles team, but each player must fill out a registration form. The standings will be based on points. Points will be awarded by where you finish the last game.

Points will be awarded as follows:

Winner on court 1 – 8 points

Loser on court 1 – 7 points

Winner on court 2 – 6 points

Loser on court 2 – 5 points

Winner on court 3 – 4 points

Loser on court 3 – 3 points

Winner on court 4 – 2 points

Loser on court 4 – 1 points

Each week of league, teams will be randomly positioned on the courts.

All games will start at the same time. Either a whistle will be blown or some sort of signal to start. Please be on the courts when the league starts.

PLEASE MAKE SURE I KNOW HOW EACH TEAM FINISHED THE LAST GAME SO I CAN FIGURE STANDINGS

Games will be timed. All games will be played for 8-10 minutes. Points will still be scored like they normally would be. Keep playing even if you reach 11 points. Basically, score as many points as you can in the time frame. At the end of the time frame a whistle will be blown signaling the end of the game. If you are in a rally continue until that point is ended. If the score is tied another rally will be played and whoever wins that rally will get the win. You do not need to be the serving team to win the final point.

At the end of each game the winners of that game will move up a court and the non-winners will move down. If you are on court one and win you will stay on court one. If you are on court 4 and are a non-winner, you stay on court 4. When you move to the new court there will be a process in place that will determine which team serves first.

Since the games are timed, it is important to keep things moving between games. We plan to play as many games as possible in 1.5 hours of play. At the end of the league, whoever finishes with the most points in each skill level will be the LEAGUE CHAMPION.

SUBS

Subs will count for league standings. When getting a sub, you will need to stay within the DUPR parameters when using a sub. For example, if you are in the 7.24 and below group the combined DUPR must remain below 7.24. Only women can sub in the Intermediate Women's group.

Method for determining side or serve

There will be 4 cards on the clipboard on each court. There will be 2 red cards and 2 black cards. Someone can shuffle the cards before the cards are selected. That person needs to hold the cards where the person choosing them cannot see the cards. One team, coming to the court, will choose a card if a red card is drawn by one of the players, they will get the choice of serving first or which side they want to play on. We will NOT be switching sides during the game so keep that in mind when choosing.
